The Commissioners and Ms. Langley decided to have the 2022 Final Budget Review on August 2nd, 2021.

Mr. Schott let the Commissioners know that we have time to plan and organize the ARPA spending.

Mr. Arensdorf gave an update on the 2021 Hot Mix projects.

Mr. Bachenberg let the Commissioners know that he is working on the Capital Needs Analysis for Kingman County.

Commissioner Thimesch let Mr. Arensdorf know that he did get in touch with the Onyx and asked them to possibly meet in the next couple of weeks with the County and some of the Cities that may be interested in their product.
