City, school board elections this spring

Kingman County residents will go to the polls this spring to elect city and school board leaders.

All seven incorporated cities in the county will elect at least two council/commission members. USD 331 Kingman-Norwich voters will elect four school board members and USD 332 Cunningham will elect five members, with one of those to fill an unexpired term.

The deadline to file for these local offices is noon on Tuesday, Jan. 27. Forms are available from the County Clerk's office in the courthouse, 130 N. Spruce in Kingman. There is a \$5 filing fee.

If needed, a primary election would be held on March 3. Citizens must register no later than Feb. 11 to vote in the primary. The Spring General Election will be April 7, with a voter registration deadline of March 17. Not sure whether you are registered to vote or your information is current? You can check your registration via a link on the Kingman County website, kingmancoks.com. The site also has the voter registration form and a link to a list of acceptable proof of citizenship documents. Proof of citizenship is required for first-time voter registration.

Advance voting will again be available for the General Election. Ballots will be mailed starting March 18 and they must be returned by the close of polls on Election Day. In-person advance voting at the County Clerk's office begins March 24 and continues until noon April 6.
