Kingman County government has entered the world of social media by launching a Facebook page to share news and information of interest to county residents.

The “Kingman County Government” Facebook page can be found on the Internet at www.facebook.com/KingmanCountyGovernment. Anyone with Internet access can view the page by using this link. Registered Facebook users will be able to “follow” the page as well as “like” and “share” content.

Nancy Borst, the county’s communications coordinator, said the Facebook page is updated regularly.

“The county realized the role social media is playing in the world today and the importance of Kingman County government participating on this platform,” she said. “Social media gives us another way to share important information with the public we serve.”

She encouraged registered Facebook users to “like” the page and “share” items from it frequently.

“We want as many members of the public as possible to receive the news and information that will be posted on the county’s Facebook page,” Borst said. “So we encourage people to ‘share’ and ‘like’ the page.”

The county also is working on a new website that will be launched this summer. The new site (kingmancoks.org) will have a fresh, modern look and also will offer opportunities for interaction with the public. The current website (kingmancoks.com) will remain active until the new site is launched.

“We are committed to using today’s technology to the best of our ability to serve the public and the new website will give us new tools to do that,” Borst said.
