Grant funds available to low-income homeowners for repairs

Low-income homeowners in Kingman County may be eligible for grant money to make basic home repairs through the Kansas Housing Preservation Grant (HPG) program.

The program is administered by the South Central Kansas Economic Development District (SCKEDD), of which Kingman County is a member. The goal of the HPG program is to repair or rehabilitate individual housing, rental properties or co-ops owned or occupied by very low- and low-income rural residents.

Jodi Suhler, SCKEDD Housing Programs director, said funds are available to serve eight more low-income homeowners in Kingman County, with an average of approximately \$2,000 per home available.

Examples of eligible work include roof leak repair, plumbing repair, electrical repair, heating/cooling system repair, guttering and accessibility issues. Only homeowners who meet income guidelines are eligible. The house can be anywhere inside an incorporated city or in any rural area of the county.

Here are the income guidelines: 1 person household, \$21,350; 2 person, \$24,400; 3 person, \$27,450; 4 person, \$30,500; 5 person, \$32,950; 6 person, \$35,400; 7 person, \$37,850; 8 person, \$40,300.
