### Commercial, heavy truck tag renewal information

The Kingman County Treasurer's Office would like to remind owners of commercial vehicles about the process to get those tags locally.

Commercial vehicle tag renewals for the coming year begin Dec. 1. This service is available at the Kingman County Treasurer's Office for in-county tags only. An appointment is required because commercial tags are a specialized service. Please call the Treasurer's Office at 532-3461 to make an appointment. Commercial tag renewals are done in the same office as driver's license services (that office is in the northeast corner of the second floor of the courthouse).

#### Heavy trucks and IRS Form 2290

Tag renewals for heavy trucks and trailers (weighing 60,000 pounds or more) may be done starting Jan. 4, 2016. The tags for these vehicles can be renewed in the county's Tag Office, located on the second floor of the courthouse. Examples of heavy trucks include wheat trucks and semi-trailer trucks used by local farmers.

Owners of these vehicles also are required to maintain a current, validated IRS form 2290. However, owners should be aware the process to obtain this IRS form has changed. Previously, owners could walk-in to the Wichita IRS office to validate their Form 2290. That is no longer the case. Anyone wanting to receive validation of this form in-person at the Wichita office must first make an appointment. That can be done by calling 1-844-545-5640 and leaving a message. The call will be returned and an appointment will be scheduled. However, the wait time for an appointment could be two weeks. The office is located at 555 N. Woodlawn, Building 4 and is open from 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday.

Form 2290 also can be completed and mailed to the IRS for validation. Kingman County has added the form (along with frequently asked questions about it) to the county's website, [www.kingmancoks.org](http://www.kingmancoks.org). Go to the Treasurer page, then click on the link to the Motor Vehicle Tag page.

The county website also has a link to e-file Form 2290 (under Quick Links on the Treasurer page). E-filing requires using a third party and paying a fee. There is no fee for non-commercial vehicles using the mail-in or walk-in system.

All heavy truck renewals must be completed by Feb. 29, 2016. Call the Tag Office at 620-532-5482 if you have any questions about heavy truck tags and staff will be happy to assist you.
