Annual severe weather program moves to theater

This year's severe weather program for Kingman County, also known as "Storm Fury on the Plains," will be held at 6:30 p.m. Monday, Feb. 22 at the Historic Kingman Theater, 237 N. Main.

"We are very excited to have the theater for our venue this year," said Fred Simon, Kingman County Emergency Manager. "It will give us a more comfortable sitting arrangement and allow more people to come to the event and not be crowded into a smaller room."

The program is presented early each spring by the National Weather Service. Chance Hayes, meteorologist with the NWS, said this year's program contains 90 percent or more new material from previous years. The program includes fun and exciting pictures and videos.

Severe weather, weather safety and how to protect yourself during a storm are among the topics to be covered. This free event is open to everyone – you do not have to commit to being a storm spotter and no pre-registration is required.

The program typically lasts about 90 minutes. Concessions will be offered with all proceeds going to benefit the theater.

This will be the only severe weather/storm spotter presentation in the county this year.
