Public's help sought after hit-and-run accident

The Kingman County Sheriff's Office is asking the public for help locating a vehicle involved in a hit-and-run accident Sept. 22.

The accident occurred at approximately 10:20 a.m. on K-11. A bicyclist traveling south on the highway and approaching NW 50th Street (just one mile south of the Reno County line) was struck by a motor vehicle also traveling south.

The motor vehicle did not stop and continued south bound. The bicyclist, an adult male from Kingman County, was taken to Kingman Community Hospital and later released.

The Sheriff's Office is looking for any information about the vehicle, which was described as a white utility truck with dual wheels and possible damage to the passing side. Help also is sought to identify the driver.
