### **Advance voting under way in Kingman County**

All registered voters in Kingman County may choose to vote early in the upcoming election in one of two ways.

Advance ballots may be requested by mail by contacting the County Clerk's office at (620) 532-2521. An application for an advance ballot is published on the Elections page of the county's website, [kingmancoks.org](http://kingmancoks.org). Simply download it to complete it on your computer.

The last day to request an advance ballot by mail is Nov. 4.

Voters also may choose to cast an advance ballot in person by coming to the County Clerk's office from Oct. 25 until Nov. 7. You may vote during normal business hours (8 a.m. to 5 p.m.) from Oct. 25-Nov. 4, and from 8 a.m. to noon on Nov. 7. Be sure to bring a valid photo ID with you.

Polls will be open on Election Day, Nov. 8 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. The Kingman County Activity Center remains the polling place for many voters, despite ongoing renovations. Simply enter through the center door on the east side and proceed to the appropriate room. Don't forget your photo ID!

A list of polling places is posted on the Elections page of the county website or you may call the Clerk at (620) 532-2521 to find out where you go to vote on Nov. 8.
