Vehicle pursuit includes Kingman County

The Kingman County Sheriff's Office was involved in a vehicle pursuit Jan. 12 that covered three counties.

At approximately 11:20 a.m., the Kingman County Sheriff's Office was alerted to a vehicle pursuit in the southwest corner of Reno County. Reno County deputies were pursuing a stolen vehicle from Hutchinson and the vehicle was failing to stop.

The stolen vehicle entered Kingman County just northeast of the City of Cunningham. Attempts to stop the vehicle by stop sticks were not successful as the vehicle was able to avoid the sticks. The vehicle turned west and the pursuit traveled through Cunningham at speeds of 45 mph. The pursuit continued into Pratt County, where the stolen vehicle drove off the roadway into a wheat field and stopped.

The driver was taken into custody without any other incident and was transported to the Reno County Jail. The vehicle was recovered with no known damage.

In addition to the Kingman County Sheriff's Office, other law enforcement agencies involved were the Reno County Sheriff's Office, the Pratt County Sheriff's Office and the Kansas Highway Patrol.
