Advance in-person voting in special congressional election begins March 29

Advance in-person voting will begin March 29 in the special election to fill Kansas' 4th District congressional seat.

The election will select the successor to Mike Pompeo (R-Kan), who resigned from Congress to become director of the Central Intelligence Agency under President Donald Trump. The 4th District includes all of Kingman County.

Registered voters may cast an advance ballot in person at the County Clerk's office in the courthouse during normal office hours from Wednesday, March 29 until noon on Monday, April 10. Voters also may request an advance ballot by mail. The deadline to request a ballot by mail is April 7. Ballots will be mailed automatically to permanent advance voters.

Election Day is April 11 and polls will be open at their usual locations across the county that day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. All ballots are due by the close of polls on Election Day. For a complete list of polling places, visit the county's website: <http://www.kingmancoks.org/2159/Elections>.
