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### **2014 Kingman County ‘Immunize! Win-a-Prize’ winner announced**



The Kansas Immunize! Win-a-Prize program recently crowned Carrie Phelps as Kingman County’s 2014 winner. Phelps wins a \$200 cash utility payment.

Immunize! Win-a-Prize! was started in 2003 by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment’s Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program. It was created to help boost infant vaccination rates to prevent dangerous vaccine-preventable illnesses for Kansas children under 2 years of age.

Families whose children receive all the recommended vaccines by their second birthday are entered in a drawing for the cash utility payment prize. One family is randomly drawn from each participating Kansas VFC provider.
