Emergency exercise to be held Sept. 19

Kingman County and various other local agencies will participate in a full-scale emergency response exercise in the City of Kingman on Sept. 19.

County Emergency Manager Fred Simon said the exercise will be held from 1 to 3 p.m. that day and will involve Kingman Community Hospital, Wheatlands Health Care Center, Kingman Christian Church and about a dozen other agencies. Exercise activity will be in an area north of US-54 Highway and west of Main Street.

Simon said he wanted the public to be aware that the exercise is a training event and not a real emergency. There will be emergency vehicles in the above locations at various times.

He also asked the public to try to avoid these facilities and this area during the exercise. These exercises are an important mechanism that allows first responders and local agencies to practice their skills so they will be better prepared to handle real emergencies.
