

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY/COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
ON September 18, 2017

The Board of Kingman County Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Meeting Room, Kingman City Hall, Kingman, Kansas on September 18, 2017. Those present:

Chairman Steffen called the Special Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners to order at 6:00p.m.

Stan Hacker, City Commissioner gave the invocation.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all in attendance.

Chairman Steffen discussed North Main and the maintenance agreement that the City and County have and would like to know if the City would like to keep the bricks on North Main and if not would they like asphalt or concrete to replace them.

Steve Bachenberg the County Engineer discussed the options for the North Main repair. Also, Mr. Bachenberg brought up the intersections at Copeland Ave, Annadale & Kansas Ave that will need to be repaired also.

City Commissioner Arensdorf let the County Commissioners know that he was okay with pulling up the bricks for just two blocks on North Main and to leave the rest in place.

City Commissioner Bishop let the County Commissioners know that he would be for concreting the first two blocks on North Main that are just North of Highway 54.

Interim City Manager Greg Graffman let the Commissioners know that they should get with Dale Robinson and have him talk with Charles Arensdorf & Steve Bachenberg to prepare plans for the process.

Mr. Bachenberg said that he felt that everyone was for taking care of North Main and would get with Mr. Robinson and Charles Arensdorf to see which option to take.

Commissioner Neville would like to fix North Main for the taxpayers of Kingman.

City Commissioner Neville would like to move on to the Expo Center and Outdoor Arena.

City Commissioner Arensdorf let the County Commissioners know that they would be adding twelve feet on the South side of the Outdoor Arena and also will be adding ADA seating when stands are placed.

County Commissioner Steffen let the City know that he felt that the Outdoor/Indoor Arena were doing well together.

County Commissioner Foley let them know that he felt it was going well also except that we have had one issue with a double booking and no payment made on the second booking.

City Commissioner Neville moved on with discussion on Trees for the fairgrounds.

All Commissioners had received correspondence from the K-State Kansas Forest Service on a four phase plan to plant trees in the fairgrounds and the Park.

City Commissioner Arensdorf brought up the possibility of adding a drive South of the current drive that could be used to cut down on the traffic during events.

County Commissioners agreed that would help with the safety during events.

City Commissioner Neville let the County Commissioners know that he appreciated how the Commissioners are working together.
